

	<ul> <li>Please see the current Home School Partnership TUITION SCHEDULE for annual fees. The application fee of \$30.00 is due at the time the application form is submitted and is <i>non-refundable</i>. After review of application and acceptance of student enrollment, the non-refundable Registration Fee per student is due.</li> </ul>
	• Our tuition is a yearly amount which may be paid in monthly installments due on the 1 <sup>st</sup> of each month (July through May). If enrolled after August 31 <sup>st</sup> , the total sum will be divided by the months remaining until May. If enrolled after the start date of the school year – tuition will be prorated as follows: Daily rate x number of school days remaining in the year. <i>Regardless of when a student is enrolled, the last payment is due May 1<sup>st</sup></i> . You may pay a higher sum anytime during the year to bring down the monthly payment.
	• Tuition payments that are 10 days late will be assessed a \$20 Late Fee. At 20 days late another \$20 Late Fee will be added. If a tuition payment becomes 30 days late the student(s) will be suspended the next school day until the account is brought up to date.
